Merrileugh is a classic family friendly beach house, made available to OTIS through the generosity of the Scott family.

Set on 800 acres of picturesque farming land, Merrileugh is located in the beautiful coastal town of Inverloch, one of Gippsland's most attractive seaside fishing ports. The town itself sits on the coast at the mouth of Anderson Inlet, a protected bay where the Tarwin River enters Bass Strait. The shallow estuary creates a stunning turquoise colour, while the beach boasts a large expanse of soft sand and is backed by low grassy dunes. At low tide you can stroll around the western headland to reach the surfing beaches.

This modest, but comfortable retreat is perfect for families or large groups looking to spend time away together.

Retreat details

Location and area

Merrileugh is a 5min drive to the centre of Inverloch, which is located on the Gippsland coast, approximately 147km (2hrs drive) south-east of Melbourne.

Enjoy the fresh country air on this working cattle farm or experience Inverloch's laidback seaside village vibe at the range of coffee shops, restaurants and boutique shops in town. The Gippsland region is well regarded for its superior local produce, which is showcased at local eateries and regular markets. Inverloch is also famed for its many dinosaur fossil discoveries.

For those who enjoy a coastal drive, the scenic Bunurong Coastal Drive will not disappoint - taking you from Inverloch to the seaside community of Cape Paterson, fronting Bunurong Marine Park. Regarded by some as a mini version of the Great Ocean Road, this coastal route offers spectacular views, untouched beaches and interesting natural attractions which visitors can stop and explore, such as Eagles Nest, Twin Reefs, Shack Bay, The Caves and Flat Rocks.

Accommodation

Merrileugh can accommodate eight guests (with additional guests permitted under special circumstances). Multiple living zones mean there is plenty of room for you to spread out and relax. The spacious lounge has a gorgeous open fireplace and there is even an indoor table tennis table in the games room. There are plenty of bedrooms - two queen rooms, two double rooms and a bunk room for the kids, serviced by two bathrooms.

Merrileugh has a fully equipped kitchen and spectacular ocean views from the kitchen/dining area and front patio.

Availability

Merrileugh is available throughout the year for up to seven nights. It is not available during school holidays.

Pets/smoking

Pets are not permitted and the property is strictly smoke-free.

Heating/Cooling

Merrileugh has an open wood fire and a small gas heater, with wood provided. Sea breezes will keep you cool in the warmer months.

Key access

The keys are available for collection from a key box located at the property. The OTIS Foundation will contact you two weeks prior to your stay, to provide the location and access information.

What to bring

All bedding linen and bath towels are provided at Merrileugh. Guests are required to bring their own food, personal items and beach towels. It has a fully equipped kitchen.

Other considerations:

Merrileugh is a working farm so you can expect passing traffic of cattle, friendly working dogs and cats. The retreat is one of three adjacent homes on the property, with the property owners living in one of the homes.
